Why Colorado Needs the Equitable Energy Upgrade and Acceleration Program

The **Equitable Energy Upgrade and Acceleration Program** (EEUAP) is a smart way to save families money, create good jobs, and build a sustainable energy system. EEUAP will help you make energy-saving investments and go solar. **The average participant will save \$120/year.**

EEUAP requires investor-owned utilities to offer these programs to all customers without the need for taking on debt. The money you save from these upgrades each month is greater than the increased monthly cost of your bill to pay for the upgrades. This means you're saving money from day one!

Colorado lawmakers are considering a bill that will enable EEUAP in the state by directing the Public Utilities Commission to create a program best suited for Colorado, such as the successful Pay As You Save® model.

How does EEUAP work?

- > An independent energy auditor comes to your home to provide an energy assessment.
 - An independent program operator oversees the audit and determines which home upgrades would most effectively lower your energy bill.
 - Depending on your home and energy bill, some upgrades may require an upfront co-pay to ensure monthly savings.
- > You pick a contractor from an approved list, who installs the upgrades specified by the program operator. The program operator confirms everything was done correctly.
- > Your utility pays for the recommended improvements.
 - This could include:
 - o Replace energy-guzzling equipment,
 - o Adding insultation,
 - Adding solar panels.
- > Your electric bill goes down because you're not using as much energy or generating energy with solar.
- The utility recovers its costs for the upgrades through a temporary charge on your bill.
- > The amount the utility charges will be less than what you save. Your total bill is lower!
- > Participating in EEUAP does not require you to take on loans, a credit check, or debt.
- > You can participate, even if you rent instead of own your home.
- > If you move, the repayment and the savings automatically transfer to the next people moving in.













How will EEUAP benefit Colorado?

Better Living

- Customers who participate in EEUAP see bill savings from day one; a typical family can save \$120 per year.
- Upgrades will allow homes to be more comfortable and safer as outdated equipment is replaced.





Create good jobs

- ➤ EEUAP supports our economy with annual estimated investments upward of \$200 million to provide energy saving improvements and another \$150 million for solar development for homes and businesses.
